

Sky Music Hub Charging, Remissions and Subsidy - Policy Statement

We believe that all pupils should have an equal opportunity to benefit from musical activities independent of their parents' financial means. We aim to provide a broad range of high quality activities and experiences and have policies in place to ensure there are no gender, race, physical, social, cultural or economical barriers to participation.

The Music Hub provides free lessons, through schools, for Looked After Children (LAC) and provides a free instrument to those pupils.

Free instrumental loans are available to all Children and Young People receiving lessons in schools via SKY Music Hub and all those attending Music Centre/extended activities which are run by SKY Music Hub.

All Music Centre and extended activities are free to children/parents.

Parents can access lessons for their children through their schools' remissions policy.

We will support schools in the development of music education of the highest quality, which is accessible to all.
